WHAT: 12th annual North Coast Harbor Boating & Fishing Fest

- Volunteers will take visitors out on Lake Erie for free power and sail boat rides
- Free fishing trips for children will be provided by the Holiday charter boat
- Life jackets and fishing kits will be given away to children while supplies last
- Capt'n Willie the Great Lakes Pirate will entertain and educate families on Sunday
- Featured boats will include B-About Sail Ministry's 65-foot schooner Journey, which will take visitors for free sailing trips all weekend, and the Cleveland Dragon Boat Association's 20-person dragon boat canoe
- The fest will be open to all and there is no charge for admission. Land-based tent displays will provide information about paddle sports, fishing techniques and safe boating practices
- The event is funded in part through grants from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources Division of Watercraft and National Water Safety Congress; and donations from the ODNR Division of Wildlife, Greater Cleveland Safety Council and Woods and Waters Club of Cleveland
